James Bond is the Chief Operating Officer of the Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency (MIGA), a member of the World Bank Group which provides political risk insurance.

Prior to his appointment in MIGA, James held numerous managerial positions at the World Bank Group. From 1986-2007, he served as Country Director for operations in sub-Saharan Africa (Benin, Côte d'Ivoire, Mali, Mauritania, and Togo, as well as Madagascar, Comoros, Mauritius and Seychelles); Director of Environmental and Socially Sustainable Development for Africa; IFC Director of Mining; Director of Energy, Mining and Telecommunications; and Division Chief of Telecommunications.

Before joining the World Bank Group, James spent 10 years in the international oil industry, notably with the French oil company, TOTAL, and the French Institute of Petroleum. He has also worked for Goldfields—a South African mining company.

James holds a Bachelors degree in chemical engineering from the University of Witwatersrand (Johannesburg, South Africa); a Masters degree in petroleum and energy economics from Ecole Française des Ingénieurs (ESPM); and a doctorate in economics (with a specialization in energy and strategic planning) from the University of Paris Pantheon-Sorbonne.
